Job Description

Objectives: · To assist physicians in the department in all matters related to patient care. · To assist the head of the department/ all doctors to department in matters Concerned with the smooth running of the departmental activities (administration/Teaching/ patient care).

In patient services :

· Meet patients, check and reply to referral letters, talk to patients and relatives. · Bring the problems faced by patients to the attention of the doctors · Ensure that the reports of investigations are made available to doctors when ward rounds are conducted. · Provide medical certificate to patients when required. · Write progress notes and problems list on the case files. · Facilitates interdepartmental consultations. · Take part in ward rounds. · Prepare discharge summaries, show to doctors. · To provide appointments for OPD visit after discharge. Coordinate with allied department like Gastroenterology, Anesthesiology, Radiology, medicine etc.

Outpatient Services :

· Help physicians in all matters concerning the patient care. · Reply to referral letters · Check weight, temperature (if indicated) · Ensure that reports of investigations sent on earlier OP visits are made available in the case file. · Provide guidance to new patients. · Provide medical certificates. · Assist physicians for procedures.

Teaching Activities :

a. Take part in all the teaching activities of the department b. Help the physicians to conduct the teaching programs c. Teach nursing and technical students

Research:

· Actively involved in research activities of the department. Collect data; make data Entry and process the data as instructed by physicians. · Help in preparation of research papers and articles for publications. Any other work in the department assigned by the Head of the Department.

PRINCIPLE DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

Preoperative Care :- 1. Perform and record history and physical examinations. 2. Write appropriate admission orders (including nursing care, medication orders,

Laboratory and radiological examinations, and obtain consultations approved by the surgeon). 3. Review pertinent abnormal findings in the patient's history, physical examination, radiological and laboratory data with the surgeon, and obtain appropriate consultation, additional laboratory or radiological studies as needed, and initiate appropriate medical intervention. 4. Record in progress notes pertinent findings from history, physical examination, Laboratory studies, and radiological examination. 5. Evaluate unstable patients and initiate emergency management (of conditions such as acute abdomen, acute/critical limb ischemia, myocardial infarction, cardiac arrest, hypothermia, shock, hemorrhage, trauma, postoperative complications etc.). 6. Confirming operating room schedule, adding urgent or emergency cases as needed. 7. Patient education as needed.

Intraoperative Care :-

First and second assist the surgeon in the operating room Case assisting in GI – surgery, vascular surgery, Liver transplantation, as first and second assistant. Place indwelling catheters, such as Foley, intravenous, and arterial catheters Assist in preparation of patient for procedure. Closure of abdomen as delegated by the attending surgeon. Assistance in the laparoscopic surgeries. Monitoring and transport of patient to ICU

Postoperative Care : -

1. Write appropriate postoperative orders including general and specific nursing care, respiratory therapy and ventilator settings, medications, including inotropes, parenteral vasodilators and controlled substances for analgesia and sedation, laboratory and radiological studies.
2. Attend the patient in the early postoperative period reviewing laboratory and radiologic data and making appropriate interventions.
3. Initiate treatment of postoperative complications such as hemorrhage, hypovolemia, hypotension, hypertension, arrhythmia, cardiac arrest, seizures, stroke, shock, renal failure, etc.
4. Advise the attending surgeon of unexpected events, providing an accurate synopsis of events related to a major change in the patient's condition and describing corrective measures already taken.
5. Daily assessment of patients postoperative course, write note of patients progress in chart as it pertains to the supervising physician- and implement indicated therapy as determined by the supervising physician.
6. Complete discharge summaries.

Physician assistants shall have the knowledge and competency to perform the

following functions, and may perform them with appropriate supervision: 1. Insert and remove intravenous lines 2. Insert and remove Foley catheters 3. Pass and remove nasogastric tubes 4. Placement and removal of chest tubes 5. Remove monitoring lines 6. Irrigate chest tubes and Foley catheters 7. Placement of central lines . 8. Control external hemorrhage 9. Cardiopulmonary resuscitation 10. Carry out aseptic and isolation techniques 11. Venipuncture 12. Draw arterial blood gases 13. Place indwelling arterial lines by percutaneous or cutdown technique 14. Evaluate CXR 15. AB Index using HHD 16. Vein marking using HHD 17. Wound management 18. Drain, debride and culture wounds
