#### **JOB PROFILE**

International Medical Centre – Apollo Sugar Clinic is a centre which offers comprehensive diabetes care. It's Oman's only and fully dedicated private centre for Diabetes. The hospital situated at Muscat has various departments under one roof – Diabetes and Endocrinology, state of the art podiatry lab and foot wear unit, Ophthalmology, Dermatology, Radiology, Physiotherapy, Dietetics and diabetes counseling with other specialty needs (Cardiology/Nephrology/Neurology) provided by Apollo hospital, Muscat.

I see patients from various nationalities and ages and a good variety of cases are seen. Most patients are referred from other centers with uncontrolled diabetes and associated complications. A good number of cases with gestational diabetes are seen daily. Patients with Type 1 diabetes are being managed at the clinic and so are a good number of early onset Type 2 diabetes and LADA variety cases. We follow guidelines laid down by recognized international bodies. Special emphasis is made to ensure that all patients receive appropriate diabetes self-management education and dietary prescription. Remission in Type 2 diabetes as a result of structured weight loss and exercise has been successful in few of our cases. Continuous glucose monitoring system (CGMS) and Flash glucose monitoring system (FGMS) are used to understand glycemic variability for certain cases. Some of our patients with Type 1 diabetes and gestational diabetes are on insulin pumps. Regular in house CMEs to train and update our staff are being conducted. I have also delivered lectures to other doctors and paramedical staff from other centers on a

periodic basis. Year after year, our clinic conducts the world diabetes day program to raise awareness on diabetes. We conduct camps at various ministry offices and companies every month to screen for diabetes. A 20 minute lecture on diabetes is also delivered to highlight the importance of early education and understanding on diabetes.
