CAREER SYNOPSIS

01. Renal Transplant unit

- Counseling patients and family members regarding the need for renal transplantation, long term prognosis, problems and expenses.
- Pre transplant evaluation of donors and recipients.
- Post renal transplant donor and recipient follow up.
- Preparing case sheet and discharge summary.

02. Dialysis unit

- Individual dialysis rounds in each shift for documenting patients' problems, prescribing medication and dialysis orders accordingly.
- Management of emergencies like accelerated Hypertension, Hyperkalemia, Hypotension during dialysis.
- To prepare dialysis summary and other medical certificates.

03. Inpatient unit

- Individual daily rounds of all inpatients, documentation of medical plan, participating in ward rounds with attending consultants, documenting progress notes, prescribing medication and investigation.
- Emergency Cardiopulmonary resuscitation support.
- Preparing discharge summaries and death summaries.

04. Outpatient clinic

- To collect medical history of new patients, do physical examination, formulating a diagnosis and order appropriate investigations.
- Brief the case to the consultant with investigation report to draw a final diagnosis and to prescribe medication accordingly with concurrence of the consultant in charge.
- To review patients on follow up along with the consultant and make further plans for continuation or modification of treatment.
- Provide medical certificates to the patients as and when required after discussing with Physician.

05. Social aspects

- Providing medical counseling to the CKD patients and attenders. Guiding the patients and helping them cope with clinical and social disease related problems.
- Replying queries from patients about kidney related disorders.

06. Research activities

- Assist Physicians in all research projects in the department.
- Data collection and documentation for various research projects.
