DETAILS OF WORK EXPERIENCE

Government T.D. Medical College, Alappuzha

Working in this government medical college with bed strength of 1050 as a junior resident and senior resident has molded me as a Pathologist.

During my junior residency I was guided by a faculty team under Dr. KP Aravindan and Dr. Sathi PP. I was given exposure in grossing and reporting in histopathology on a daily basis. Hematology cases with complete clinical and pathological work up with discussions were done regularly. I had ample exposure in FNAC and cytology reporting. Weekly slide discussions, topic discussions and recent advance topic discussions were given in our department. I could participate in Interdepartmental discussions, tumor board and case discussions. I was given exposure in immunohistochemistry and immunofluorescence. I was also given 3 month posting and training in Forensic Department where I was given opportunity to do autopsies. Pathological autopsy cases with histology were discussed with faculty. I also had 3 month exposure in Transfusion Medicine Department. I have taken classes in general pathology, systemic pathology and clinical pathology for undergraduate students throughout my residency. I did my subject thesis on '**Mast Cells and Chronic Inflammation in Papillary Carcinoma Thyroid**' under the guidance of Dr. KP Aravindan. I cleared my MD exit exam in May 2014.

After my junior residency I worked here for 1.5 years in total on contract basis as Senior Resident. I worked in histopathology where I did grossing, reported histopathology independently including immunohistochemistry. I actively participated in undergraduate teaching, post graduate students weekly discussions and collecting wet gross specimens for museum. I was given 6 months in clinical pathology where I reported peripheral smears, FNAC slides and pap smears individually.

Primary Health Centre, Vettakal, Alappuzha

I was posted here for a period of 1 year. This PHC had 6 beds with inpatient services and was situated in Tsunami affected coastal region of Chertala. I conducted daily OP services, immunization checkups, community health visits, filarial control programs, family planning programs and mother and child care.

Government Medical College, Thiruvanthapuram

It was dream come true for me to do my bachelor's degree from one of the best medical colleges of Kerala. I did my internship in this 3000 bed hospital with clinical rotations in various departments from February 2008 to January 2009. Here I gained my initial medical experience as an undergraduate and the importance of a doctor in serving the community. I acquired basic skills and expertise in various procedures which were done at various departments. Diagnostic aspects especially case work up fascinated me and the role of Pathology in it was highlighted during this period.
