Transplant:

- Management of intradialytic emergencies like accelerated hypertension, hyperkalemia and hypotension
- To explain condition of the patient to the bystander during dialysis
- To write dialysis orders and medications
- Prepare dialysis summaries and letters.
- Assisting in procedures like kidney biopsy, Femoral catheterization and Internal Jugular Catheterization

Ward responsibilities:

- Completing individual daily rounds on all inpatients, documentation
 of medical plan, participating in ward rounds with attending
 consultants daily, providing routine medical management of
 inpatient care including writing physician orders and progress
 notes in case files, ordering of the diagnostic tests, labs,
 radiological investigations, and advising proper nutrition.
- Preparing discharge summaries

OPD responsibilities:

- Evaluating the patients, obtaining medical history, vital signs and performing physical examination and summarizing the cases to the Nephrologists.
- To take medical history, formulating a diagnosis and treating the long term illnesses under supervision of consultants, for disease like Nephrotic syndrome in children and adults, Systemic lupus erythematosus, Primary glomerular diseases, Interstitial diseases and Renal calculus disease
- Provide medical certificates to the patients as and when required after discussing with Physician.
