Duties and responsibility in Anaesthesia phase

- 1. Assist anesthetics during the procedure in the operation theatre and intensive Care unit.
- 2. Preparing the anaesthesia workstation and required monitor for anaesthesia.
- 3. Keep the anaesthesia drugs and equipments ready for the procedure.
- 4. Understanding the anaesthetic requirements of different surgical procedures and management of crisis.
- 5. Checking the functionality of gas delivery system and ensure safe administration of anaesthetic gases.
- 6. Cleaning and maintaining of equipment used for anaesthesia and sterilizing it for next case usage.
- 7. Ensuring availability of anaesthesia drugs and another consumable used for anaesthesia procedure.
- 8. Periodic maintenance of anaesthesia ventilator, monitor and other equipments used in operation theatre.
- 9. Ensuring safe disposable needles and biomedical waste management.
- 10. Assisting the anesthesiologist in radiology suite during MRI and interventional procedure.
- 11. Part of the trauma rescuestation team in management of traumatic brain injury and cardiac rescuestation team.
- 12. Assisted the anesthesiologist for providing Local Anaesthesia, General anaesthesia, Regional anaesthesia (spinal and epidural anaesthesia).
- 13. Assisted the anesthesiologist during videolaryngoscopy, fiberoptic intubation, LMA insertion and difficulty airway management.
- 14. Trained to place Endotracheal intubation, Oral and nasopharyngeal airway and mask ventilation.

Duties and responsibility in recovery phase

- 1. Takes the patient to the recovery room
- 2. Monitor the patient until they recover from the effects of surgery and the anesthetics.
- 3. Checks the complications such as patient airway, breathing, circulation, disability, exposure.
- 4. monitoring vital signs(heart rate, blood pressure, temperature, and respiratory rate) and Invasive monitoring such as arterial lines, central venous lines, and ventriculostomies.
- 5. Preparation and administration of intravenous, epidural, or perineural infusions.
- 6. Monitoring surgical site for excessive bleeding, mucopurulent discharge, swellings, hematomas, wound healing and infection.
- 7. Providing anti-sickness medication as necessary.
- 8. Providing pain relief as necessary.
- 9. Providing warming device as necessary.
- 10. Liaising with wards and other departments.
- 12. Liaising with theatres and Anaesthetists.
- 13. Decides when the patient is ready to return to their ward and providing a detailed handover patient's operation to the ward staff.
- 14. Also experience in Med Surg, Critical Care, PACU, SICU, recovering post-surgical patients.
