## **DESCRIPTIVE STUDY ON FACTORS ASSOCIATED**

# WITH ANTIFUNGAL MEDICATION ADHERENCE AMONG PATIENTS WITH DERMATOPHYTOSIS, BENGALURU

**OBJECTIVE**: To determine the factors that influences non- compliance among patients who are on antifungal medications as deramtophytosis is a common cause which in turn results in reoccurrence and worsening of the infection.

- The study was conducted at ESI MC-PGIMSR & Model Hospital, Rajajinagar, which is a 500 bedded Hospital with state of art facilities for patients.
- This study was a three -month observational study with sample size of 305 patients visiting the outpatient clinic.

**OUTCOME**: Observational study outcome showed that most of the patient were non-compliant to medication due to various factors such as age, gender, knowledge about the disease, inadequate hygiene.

• These factors where determined using medication KAP questionnaire and medication adherence in each individual was determined using Morisky Green Levine scale.
