Emergency procedures

Over past decade I have been able to horn my talent in various emergency procedures like

- Inter Costal Drain insertion, fluid resuscitation, intravenous cannulation, central line insertion, endotracheal intubation, tracheostomy, venesection, giving CPR, ryles tube insertion
- Emergency laparotomy, splenectomy, right hemicolectomy,
 Appendicectomy, orchidectomy, orchidopexy, hernia tissue repair
 (bassini, dasarda, sholdice), grahams patch repair, triple tube repair for peptic perforation, resection anastomosis, gastro-jejunostomy, stoma formation (jejunostomy, ileostomy, colostomy), amputation, reduction of rectal prolapse, thiersch repair

Elective procedures

- Minor: Excision of cysts/ lipoma/ palmar ganglion, banding of hemorrhoids, skin suturing, fibroadenoma excision, round block mastopexy (fibroadenoma, gynecomastia)
- Open: Lichtenstein Mesh henioplasty, elective appendicectomy, open mesh hernioplasty (onlay), Modified Radical mastectomy, stoma reversal, open cholecystectomy, Split thickness skin grafting, fistula-in-ano (fistulectomy, fistulotomy, seton insertion), mulligan Morgan excision
- 3. Laparoscopy: Laparoscopic cholecystectomy (4 port)

- Open: thyroidectomy, superficial parotidectomy, abdomino-perinealresection, abdominal dermoid tumor excision, diaphragmatic hernioplasty, rectal prolapse (mesh fixation)
