PATIENT CARE AND RESPONSIBILITIES

- Hot and cold application (Eg- ice bag, hot water bag, cold compress, sterile hot compress and cold sponge).
- Personal hygiene including assist in activities of daily living.
- Tracheostomy care of the patient (Eg- suctioning and tracheostomy dressing).
- Care of pressure sore (frequent back care and positioning).
- Familiar with all protocols, administration of blood and blood products and care of immune compromised patients.
- DVT prophylaxis
- Surgical dressing.
- Suctioning.
- Prevention of aspiration.
- Steam inhalation.
- Nasogastric and peg tube feeding.
- Care of ICD.
- Blood transfusion
- Care of invasive catheters (IV cannula, Foley's catheter).
