- 1. Familiar with various ventilators which includes Engstrom, Carescape, Maquet, Hamilton c1and c3, mindray
- 2. Assisted physicians with Intubations, Bronchoscopies, Thoracenteses, Tracheostomy and other procedures.
- 3. Part of Code Blue team
- 4. Assisted Bronchoscopy
- 5. Handled various oxygen delivery devices ranging from nasal prongs to Mechanical Ventilation
- 6. Handled critical respiratory cases including Covid pneumonia
- 7. Helped patients get weaned from mechanical ventilator to self ventilating, helped them to improve their oxygenation using various respiratory breathing exercises, chest physiotherapy and mental support
- 8. Conducted follow-up visits with patients to evaluate treatment outcomes and make recommendations for additional care if needed.
- 9. Collaborated with interdisciplinary team members and developed individualized plans of care based on assessment findings, patient needs and physician orders.
- 10. Assessed patient's response to therapeutic interventions by observing physical conditions or interpreting test results and evaluated their need for additional resources sources such as home health services or durable medical equipment.

- 11. Instructed patients on proper use of respiratory equipment including oxygen therapy, ventilators and aerosol therapy.
- 12. Consulted with physicians about potential problems related to prescribed respiratory therapies or medications.
- 13. Identified high risk situations such as airway obstruction or inadequate ventilation and took appropriate action.
- 14. Provided emergency care when required including performing cardiopulmonary resuscitation.
- 15. Attended staff meetings, educational conferences and seminars related to respiratory therapy practice.
- 16. Conducted cardiopulmonary resuscitation and airway maintenance.
- 17. Set up and monitored mechanical ventilators, therapeutic gas administration apparatus and aerosol generators and handled associated critical care duties.
- 18. Interacted with patients, family members and physicians to coordinate patient care.
- 19. Performed bronchopulmonary drainage and assisted patients with breathing exercises.
- 20. Monitored patient's vital signs, arterial blood gases or blood chemistry changes, consulting with physician during adverse reactions.
- 21. Managed care of patients with diverse conditions alongside physicians, nurses and support team members.
- 22. Collaborated with physicians, nurses or other healthcare professionals to manage patient care by assisting with medical procedures or related duties.
